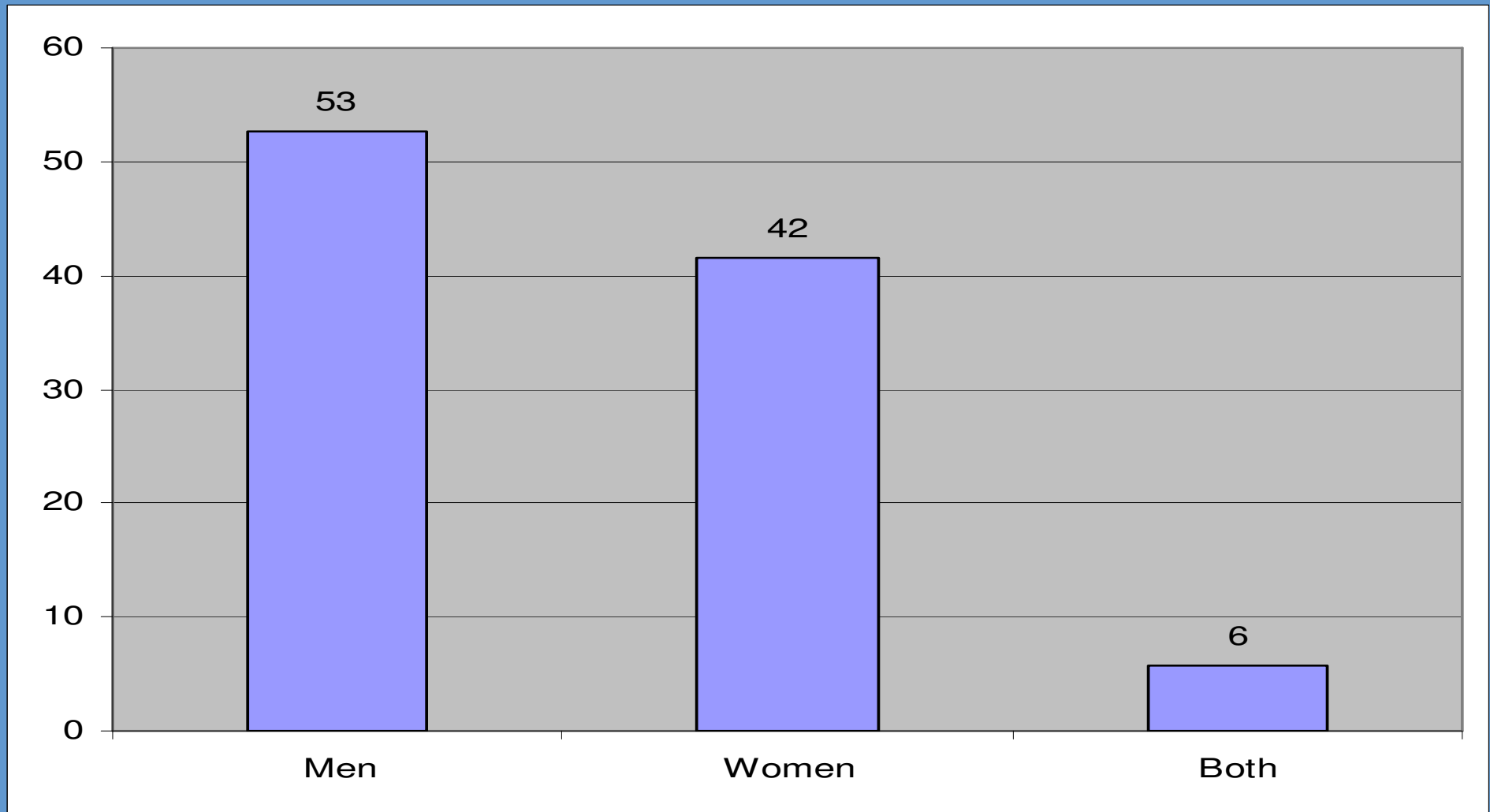

(IOM Counter Trafficking Database, 78 countries, 1999-2006, n=9646)





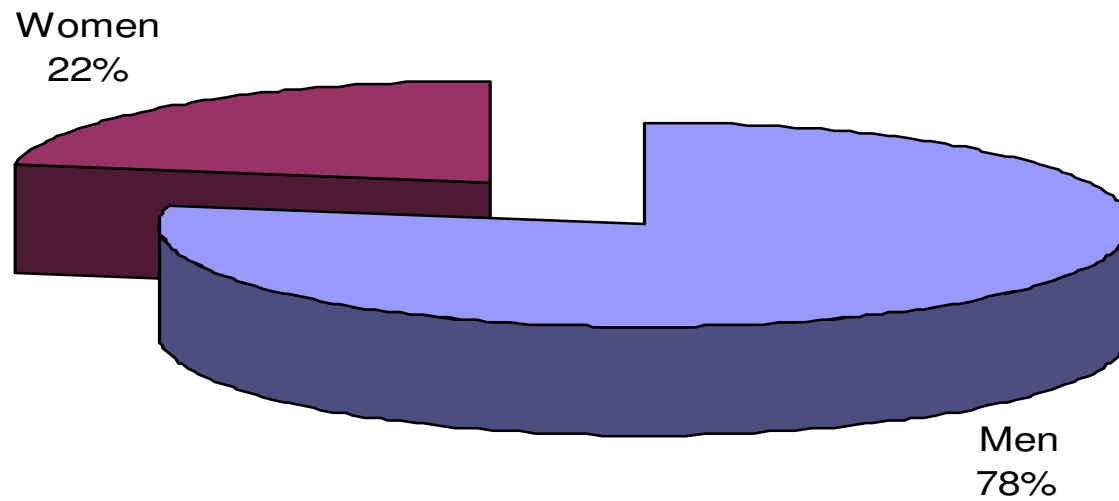
Sex of Suspects

- **27 % of victims exploited by women**

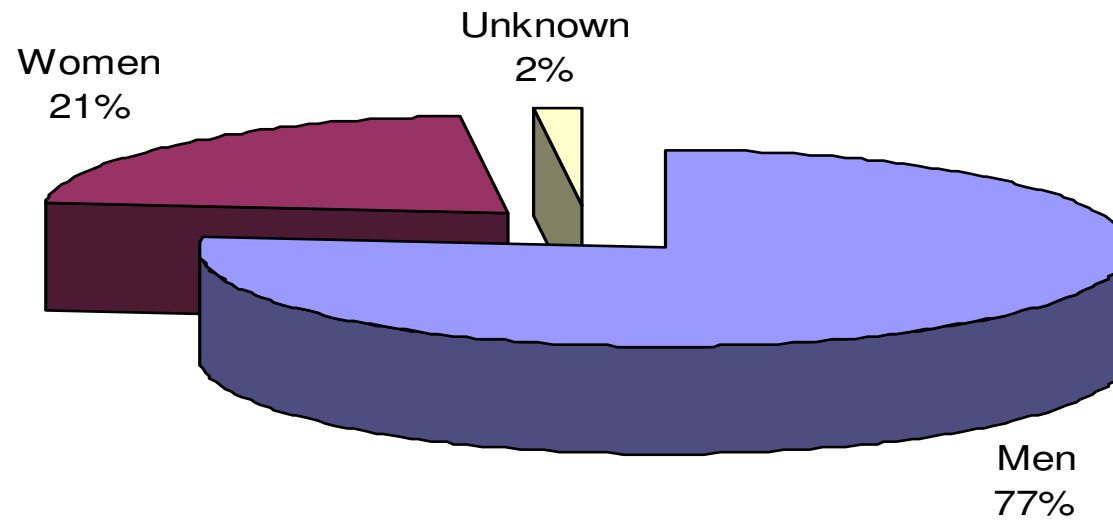


Sex of Suspects (Dutch National Rapporteur, 1998-2002)



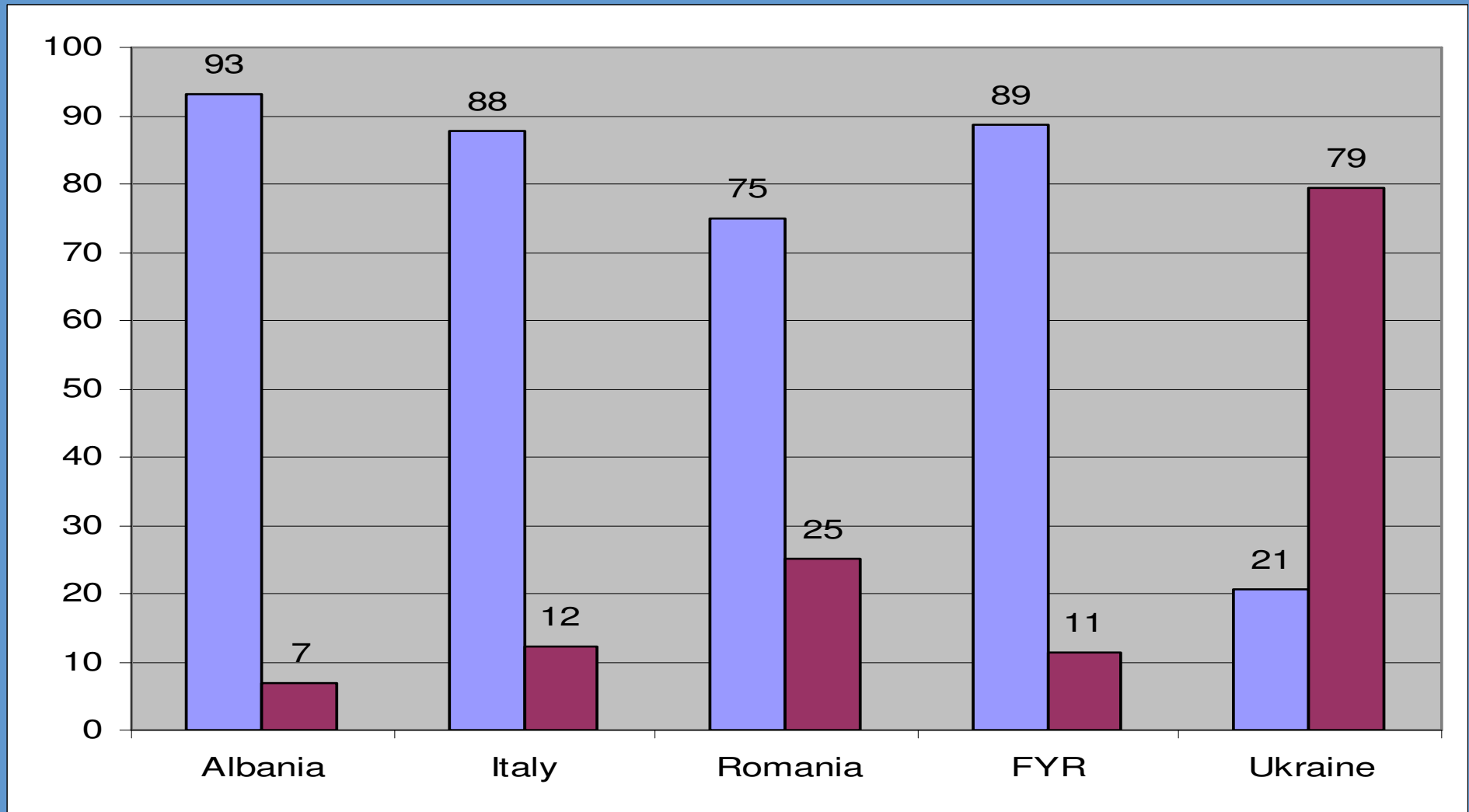


Sex of Suspects recorded in Germany by BKA (BKA, 2004, n=777)



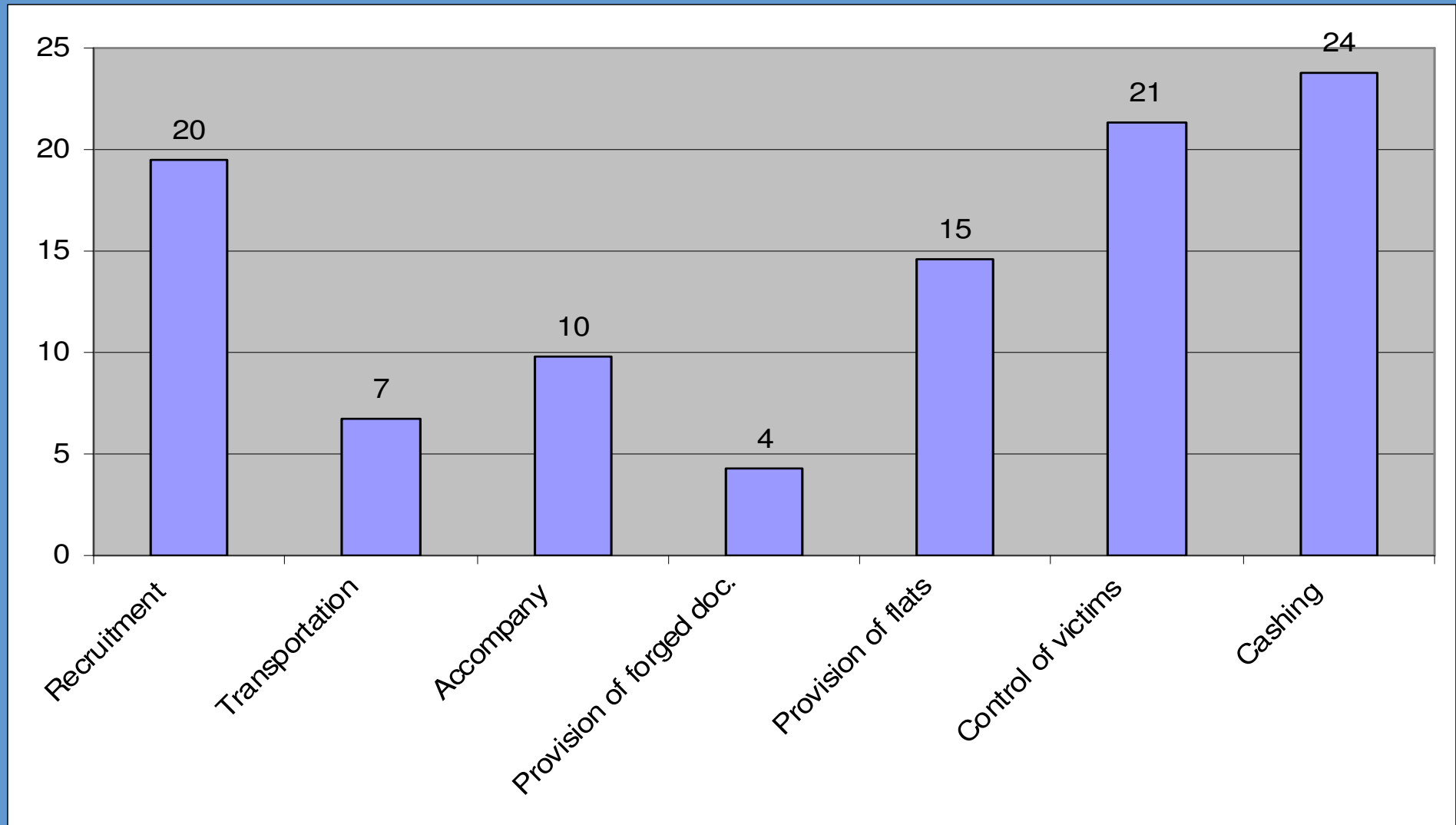


Sex of Traffickers in Italy, 1996-2003 (WEST, 2005)

Slovakia:

- **25% of the prosecuted persons are women in trafficking cases (UNODC, 2006)**

Nigeria:

- **60% of prosecuted persons are women in trafficking cases**
- **50% of convicted traffickers are women (NAPTIP, 2006)**
